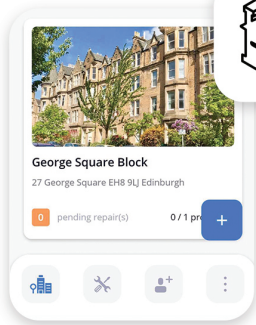

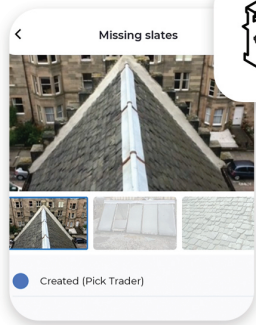
Creating your virtual tenement

The first step is to create or join your **virtual tenement**. If you have an **invitation code**, then join a virtual tenement. If not, go ahead and create a new one.



You don't need to invite all owners to join the app. It works great with only one user!

Creating a repair and hiring third parties

Create a report for any repair or maintenance issue and send it to a professional (a trader and, soon, a surveyor).

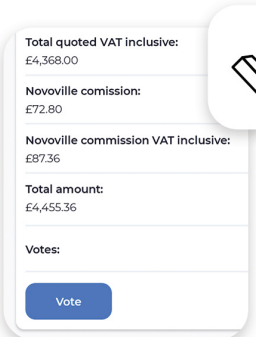
There are **hundreds of vetted traders** to choose from in the app. These are members of Trusted Traders Scotland, or a similar local scheme. You can also invite your own trader.

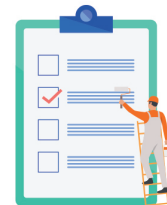

Voting and paying

Specify which owners are required to pay for the repair or maintenance job. Once you have received quotes, you can record the votes of all owners in the app. It's fast and convenient.



In minutes, create a dedicated payment account for your tenement within the app for free, and make everything transparent. It's your account, and your money is protected.

And just in case...

The app creates a paper trail. Your local council may be able to provide you with assistance (e.g. release of ownership details, missing share, etc.) — show them what you have done with the app.



The app contains pre-filled letters to help you communicate with all members of your stair!
